What is laser hair removal?

Cosmetic procedure that uses a powerful laser or intense pulsed light (IPL) to remove unwanted hair. This light source heats and destroys hair follicles in the skin, which disrupts hair growth.

Frequency of treatment

- 5 - 10 Treatments are required to have efficient results.
- The first 5 sessions should be performed every two weeks and there after every 4 weeks.

Preparation before the treatment

- Skin is shaved the day before or waxed two days before
- Free of creams, makeup or deodorant.

Not recommended for

- People who suffer from skin cancer or have done in the past.
- If you have epilepsy.
- If you have any form of herpes simplex. (blisters or nerve system)
- If you suffer from blood clotting.
- If you are on any medication that make your skin more sensitive to light.
- If you have been treated with Accutane in the past six months.
- If you have been on a course of steroids in the past three months.
- If you had skin exfoliation in the past two weeks.
- Underwent radiation in the past three months.

Not recommended on the following areas:

- On or next to an active implant.
- On tattoos or permanent makeup.
- On dark brown or black patches.
- On sunburns that have not yet been healed.

Possible side effects

- Slight skin irritation.
- Reddening of skin
- Increased sensitivity

Aftercare treatment

- Apply smooth lotion such as Aloe Vera.
- Do not use exfoliator or whitening lotion for the next 24 hours.
- Avoid more than 15 minutes of sunlight for the next 48 hours.
- Do not remove hair on the treated areas using wax or tweezers for the next week.
